If you like music, especially the oldies, I'm sure you recognize the following names: The Beach Boys, The Carpenters, The Association, Neil Diamond, Simon and Garfunkel. But what about the following names, Tommy Tedesco, Billy Strange and Chuck Findley? If you are a fan of music from the 1960's and 1970's you have heard music played by the second list of names more than the first list. These "unknowns" and 15 or 20 others were nicknamed "The Wrecking Crew." They were studio musicians in Los Angeles in the 60's and 70's who provided the instrumentation for many of the songs we all recognize as hits from that era. In fact, Tommy Tedesco is believed to be the most recorded guitarist in history! The famous vocalists were important to making a hit song, but those unknown musicians brought the music to life! You know, in life what is out of public view is where the life really is at. Even our bodies testify to this. Our internal organs are far more important to sustaining life than our external attributes. Spiritually, what is happening in our heart directs the outcome of our external life. So, is your spiritual life like a hit song, or a clunker?
