Sermon: By Faith, Simeon and Anna

<u>Scriptures:</u> Luke 2:22-38; Isaiah 40:1-5; Isaiah 66:12-13; Psalm 25:14;

<u>Introduction:</u> We continue our series on faith. Since this is Christmas in July Sunday, we will look closely at two people in the birth narrative of Jesus. Although they are not listed in the



key text of Hebrews 11, they are wonderful examples of individuals who lived by faith in the Lord God of Israel. The scene for this mornings message takes place in the temple complex in Jerusalem at the time of Jesus. Referred to as the 2nd Temple period, it was built by Jewish governor Zerubbabel around 521 BCE. It was later enhanced and expanded by Herod the Great in the 1st century BC, resulting in the structure being known as Herod's Temple.
